Claire Bury explained the current situation in the EU: the EU strict framework on GM-crops. Still we need to consider new techniques. The Farm to Fork Strategy will keep up with new innovative techniques. However, products produced by new genomic techniques are very difficult to track, which is quite different from the situation with traditional GMOs. The Council has asked the Commission on a study on New Breeding Techniques, this will be ready around Easter 2021.
