Regarding your information request on potential consent applications for modified organisms by means of the new mutagenesis techniques, or their field trials, we have to inform you that there is not such activity in Greece, due to the fact that deliberate release of GM Plants is not approved.

There is still a big suspiciousness of the public against GMO used for food and feed and hence not much GM plants-related research.

Consumers prefer food and feed grown on traditional ways, thus it would be impossible to sell GM seeds in Greece.
