With reference to your letter of 16th October, concerning the data on new mutagenesis techniques in Estonia, we apologize for the late reply and send you the following information.

As far as we have information, there are no registered varieties with new mutagenesis techniques in Estonian national catalogue of varieties. There are several rapeseed varieties - Clearfield 7130 CL, Mobil CL and Cobira CL in our catalogue, but we are of the opinion that these varieties are not bred with new mutagenesis techniques. We have also received applications for entrance of Clearfield varieties named Chart CL, Chevy CL and Chip CL into our national catalogue of varieties and these varieties will pass growing trials as usual varieties.
