We would like to inform you that a new request for registration of a citizens' initiative has been received via the European Citizens' Initiative official register.

The proposed initiative is entitled 'Grow scientific progress: crops matter!'.

Please find attached and below details of the request for registration as provided by the organisers.

Following the legal analysis of admissibility of this initiative by the Legal Service, the registration request will be subject to a Decision to be adopted by the College of Commissioners.

The legal deadline for replying to the registration request is **25 July 2019**.

The registration of a proposed initiative by the Commission is a pre-condition for the start of the process of collection of statements of support from citizens.

The assessment of the Commission at the stage of registration is of a legal nature only, and does not prejudice the final legal and political conclusions of the Commission on this initiative and the action it will intend to take, if any, in the case organisers do manage to collect the required number of statements of support from citizens.
