ATTENTION: Dr.

1. The newly organized [redacted] of the Central Intelligence Agency is seriously interested in determining the feasibility of using [redacted] in specialized operational situations.
2. The use of [redacted] in specialized operations seems promising and deserves support. However, we feel that considerable study is required to more accurately define the operational limitations inherent in the [redacted] in close cooperation with other departments having similar interests.
3. Recognizing that the [redacted] has had long and continuing interest in this area, we wish to explore with you ways in which we could augment research; specifically, we would like to undertake active collaboration with appropriate units of the [redacted] to determine the feasibility of using [redacted] /situations. Perhaps active collaboration would lead to a more rapid solution of the problems involved with a minimum of duplication. I would welcome your comments on this matter.
