I. Attached is the Proposal upon which you solicited \comments. I have discussed the paper at some length with appropriate individuals in this Division and find that we are in general agreement on several points. First, the brevity of description of experimental work to be performed is such that are assessment of the "quality of content" of the proposal does not appear to be possible particularly in view of the very specialized interests of in these matters. Far from being negative in this respect; this concensus appears to involve the thought that the proposed work covers such a broad area and involves so many possible test substances that some materials of interest must almost certainly be discovered.
