1. This is in response to referent and records my understanding of the agreements we reached when Messrs. [redacted] met with me on 9 April to discuss this general subject.

2. Your plans and recommendations for [redacted] are entirely satisfactory. I would like to be briefed in due course on the [redacted] of this effort.

3. With regard to [redacted] no CIA money is to be provided during Fiscal Year 1970, and to the extent that [redacted] wishes to fund this program we will continue to administer it as we have in the past. I understand that there will be a demonstration on or about 15 July following which fundamental decisions will be made as to follow-on work. I would also like to be briefed on this before the work is undertaken.

4. I have no objection to a modest expenditure in connection with the cats, but I would like to know more specifically what is proposed and how much money is going into the effort before it is undertaken.
