MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

26 May 1952

SUBJECT: Artichoke

1. [redacted] of [redacted] phoned today saying that [redacted] is in town and had hoped to talk to [redacted]. [redacted] is going on another trip and is looking for guidance. [redacted] felt that it was inappropriate to give guidance, to which I agreed, and I suggested that he simply ask [redacted] to pick up any information in this field which he happened to run across. [redacted] said that he would get us off the hook as far as talking to [redacted] was concerned on the basis of [redacted] non-availability. A

2. Later today, [redacted] came in to tell me that he had dined with [redacted] last night, and that [redacted] was very anxious to pass on to us information about certain materials which [redacted] had manufactured, and which had reached the Soviets. I suggested that [redacted] have the information extracted by the [redacted] office, and that a copy of the report be sent personally to me. A G
