

## Confidentiality of Potential Supplier's Information

<b>Information in the Contract considered necessary to be confidential</b>	<b>Reasons for requesting confidentiality</b>
<b>Potential Supplier's Details</b>	Personal data relating to the Supplier, its subsidiaries, employees, contractors and consultants are confidential to the Supplier and are to remain confidential to comply with data protection legislation and meet stringent data security protocol. Time sensitivity is in perpetuity.
<b>Case Studies and references to previous and ongoing work</b>	The Supplier works with a range of government clients; the contracts it works on are therefore commercially sensitive, sometimes classified, and the Supplier is subject to strict confidentiality obligations which prevent it from publicly disclosing any details regarding our work. Time sensitivity is in perpetuity.
<b>Attachment 4 – Price Model</b>	The Supplier considers its pricing structure to be commercially sensitive and therefore confidential. Allowing the publication of its commercial pricing would potentially constitute unfair competition, prejudicing the Supplier in future procurement opportunities and ultimately reducing market competitiveness. Time sensitivity is for 10 years.
