1. References b., c. and d. contain Vienna's instructions to Salzburg regarding identifying Subject; our initial reply stating there was no information in NSAF files; and Vienna's permission to run unilateral police traces through GREENWICH-1, respectively.

2. GREENWICH-1's initial report (received on 31 October 1961) states that

Semen POBORILIJ - born 2 February 1910 in Cherkassy/Ukr., married, teacher, Ukrainian citizen, resided at the refugee camp in Siezenreith, Salzburg, from 13 July 1950 to 23 August 1950. Prior to 13 July 1950 he lived at the Hellbrunn refugee camp in Salzburg. According to police records Subject left Salzburg for the United States on 23 August 1950.

3. Additional information in the form of a photographic copy of the official police registration card and a negative of an identification photograph of Subject, both dated 7 November 1947 reveals that

Semen POBORILIJ - born 2 February 1910 in Przysyl, is a Polish citizen, married, teacher, 176 cm tall, gray eyes, blond hair, oval face, no prominent or identifying features.

The date on the registration card presumably indicates the date on which Subject was first officially registered by the Salzburg police.

4. We are returning to Vienna the photograph sent us under reference b. for their retention. We have also attached the identification negative noted in the preceding paragraph. Would Vienna please make prints for SR and Paris and attach them to their copies of this dispatch.

1. Reference is made to previous correspondence from this office regarding the Subject and to your file number 105-93295.

2. An official French liaison source reported in early September 1961 that Antin MYCZPORUK received a letter with the return address: (fmu) DIALNAWSKY, 63/W. 7 SA. (sic) Philadelphia 23, Pa. The address was also received from an official U.S. source as 13/W 7 SA. but this is believed to be a typographical error. It has not been possible to verify the address as the envelope was not photographed but was passed routinely from the post office to MYCZPORUK. The letter was not tested for secret writing.

3. The files of this Agency contain no identifiable information on DIALNAWSKY. It is possible the address should be 631 North Seventh Street, Philadelphia, which is the one used by PCHORILIV. According to information from your Bureau, this is the home of Dymtro WASYLASZUK, Secretary of the Ukrainian Workmen's Association and the residence may be used for meetings of that organization.

4. We would appreciate any information in your files on DIALNAWSKY.

3. It should be noted that our work on known systems revealed two cases exhibiting the same type of fleeting detection as was noted on the ROSENBLUM letter. This, of course, does not mean that the ROSENBLUM letter is written in one of these systems, but merely that fleeting detections can occasionally be expected with this variation of the KEMFOTE TEST.

1. Attached is a photograph of Semen POHORILIV, which we would like shown, without name, to appropriate unilateral sources for possible identification.

2. FYI: POHORILIV's name appears as the sender of a letter containing secret writing to Artin MYCZYPOK in Paris, France. The letter was sent in care of Deytro (DEYF, another Ukrainian resident of Paris. DEYF, in November 1940, asked ANDOGWA/1 to deliver the letter to MYCZYPOK who was confined to a mental sanitarium near Paris. DEYF told ANDOGWA/1 that he (DEYF) and MYCZYPOK had been involved with Vasily KRAVCHENKO (Soviet assigned to UNESCO and the case officer of the arrested emigre Grigoriy BENTZELCOE), and therefore DEYF feared coming to the attention of the French police by delivering the letters to MYCZYPOK. MYCZYPOK analysis revealed the presence of the s/w in the letter from POHORILIV, but failed in attempts to develop the s/w. COESVY and Paris Station are *not* investigating this case; therefore, in your reply please send an information copy to Paris.

1. Reference is made to memorandum from this office, CSCI-3/764,636 of 24 April 1961, and to your memorandum of 3 May 1961, file number 105-93295.

2. As reported in referenced CSCI memorandum, a letter purportedly from Subject was tested for secret writing. Secret writing was seen by one technician and its presence confirmed by another technician. However, the message had disappeared before a third technician could observe it. The technician who tested the letter has said that only one line of hand-printed secret writing was distinctly visible. There were traces of S/W on other parts of the letter but this was very indistinct. The cover letter was in longhand. The disappearance of the writing did not permit photography or recording of any part of the S/W message.

2. We would appreciate being informed whether or not you have had an opportunity to compare the hand writing of Semen POHORILIN and that of the letter bearing his name and address, which we sent to you with reference 1.b..

3. In a review of our files we note that the lack of elaboration in our earlier correspondence might cause your Bureau some difficulty. Our statement in reference 1.c. that the POHORILIN letter bore indications of secret writing was based on the findings of our technical staff. One of our technicians applied a test that permitted him to see writing which, although it was not legible, could be seen to be other than that of the overt text. This writing remained visible long enough for another technician

to confirm its presence. There have been reports that our source is considered by the Soviets to be American controlled. Thus it was considered that, if this letter were a Soviet intelligence communication, it was likely the Soviets would consider the operation compromised when our source's possession of the letter was reported. For this reason, we decided it was best to forge a copy of the POHORILIN letter and make every attempt to develop any secret writing it contained. Unfortunately, we were unable to do so, and the original letter was destroyed in the process. As we reported in reference l.d. on 8 or 9 January 1961 our source delivered to Antin NYCZYPOBUK the forged copy of the POHORILIN letter. To date there has been no report of any reaction to NYCZYPOBUK's receipt of the forgery.

Dmitric \*GNYP, born 13 October 1898 at WASNICZU, Hungary - child of Wassile and JAZWINSKA Paraska, Ukrainian refugee, has lived for about the past twenty years at 211 rue de Bercy, Paris 12eme.

He has been employed, since 1945, as night watchman for the "Societe de Transports de Vehicules Automobiles", 60 rue St. Ferdinand, Paris 17eme.

His monthly salary is about 60,000 old francs.

From his first marriage, he had two sons, Baseli (36 years old) who lives in Poland and Lwitomir (34 years old) who lives in the USA.

From his second marriage with Martha MASLY, born 9 September 1903 in LHOV Poland, he had a third son Jean, born 22 May 1940 in Paris (12th arrondissement) who chose a French nationality.

During the German occupation, GNYP who has been in France since 1925 went to work in Germany as a volunteer for the organization TODT. Returning to France in 1943 he worked until the Liberation as a chauffeur for the "Legion SPEER" at Enghien Les Bains.

In 1944, with the liberation, he was arrested and interned at Fresnes for collaboration, but this detention was not followed by condemnation.

In the milieu of Ukrainian refugees he is considered as an opportunist.

Antin \*NYKYPORUK, born the first of January 1912 in Karkow (Ukraine), bachelor, has most recently lived at 86 rue de Montreuil-arrived in France in 1950.

He first of all was a manual laborer, and then an electrician.

Bothered with mental troubles, he has been interned since 1954 in various psychiatric hospitals.

His last stay was in 1959 at Villejuif.

Since his departure, his activity and sources of income have not been known because his unemployment payment has been refused by the "Bureau de la Main d'Oeuvre".

His ordinary resident's card has lapsed since 16 August 1960 and he is actually violating the law for Foreigners.

It is a question of a violent individual when he has his mental crises.

On several occasions the police have intervened to control him before interment.

1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 22 November 1960 on Subject.

2. There have been no new developments in France on this matter. Our source has been given a facsimile of the POHORILIV letter, but there has been no report on its delivery to Antin HYZEPORUK (see attachment).

3. We have received the following biographic information:

a. Dmytro GHYP was born on 13 October 1898 at Wasycaya Rohatyn, Western Ukraine. He is married and the father of two sons, one of whom repatriated to the Ukraine in 1948 and the other of whom lives in France and is a member of the Ukrainian nationalist organization - Spilka Ukrainskoj Molodi (The Union of Ukrainian Youth in France). GHYP's education consists of four years of elementary schooling in the Ukraine. In 1918 he served as a non-commissioned officer in the Ukrainian Army in a formation called the Sitschovi Strilci. GHYP emigrated to France in 1925. He has been a member of two Ukrainian communist organizations in France; in 1927 he joined the Soyuz Ukrainskych Hromadian u Francji (Union of Ukrainian Citizens in France), and from 1945 to 1947 he was a member of the Bathivtchyna (Homeland). His address for the past two years has been 211 Rue de Bercy, Paris XIIIes.

b. Antin NYCZYFORUK (according to GHYP his true name is NYKYPORETZ) was born about 1910. He is married and had a wife and two children in Moginak. Prior to 1944 he was a professor of Ukrainian and West European Literature at a pedagogical institute in Kiev. NYCZYFORUK left the USSR in 1944; from 1945 to 1948 he was in an International Refugee Organization camp in Salzburg, Austria; he has resided in France since 1948.

4. The following details on GHYP's and NYCZYFORUK's involvement with Soviet intelligence were obtained by our source from GHYP and other Ukrainian emigres in France. During the period 1958 to 1960 GHYP and Vasilii MYAKUSHKO, Third Secretary of the Soviet Delegation to UNESCO, frequently visited with each other at the Soviet Embassy and at GHYP's apartment on 211 Rue de Bercy. At the end of 1959 GHYP introduced NYCZYFORUK to MYAKUSHKO. MYAKUSHKO asked NYCZYFORUK to contribute literary articles to Soviet publications; it is not known whether NYCZYFORUK wrote any such articles. Early in 1960 NYCZYFORUK developed a persecution complex and was confined to a sanitarium for a short period. GHYP, fearing that NYCZYFORUK might expose the GHYP-MYAKUSHKO relationship, provided NYCZYFORUK with free board and lodging in his apartment and with spending money. MYAKUSHKO dropped NYCZYFORUK as soon as the latter's mental condition became obvious. In May 1960 the Soviet Embassy advised NYCZYFORUK to repatriate to the USSR as soon as possible, and offered to help locate his family in the USSR. (As you already know, in October 1960 the Soviets sent NYCZYFORUK a letter reporting his family was not in Moginak. See attachment.)

5. There is a rumor in the Ukrainian exigre colony in Paris that NYCZYFORUK has been a Soviet agent since about 1949. This is based on his close relationship with Josef (aka Oayp) KOZAK since 1949. KOZAK moved to France from Munich in 1946. Until his expulsion in 1950 he was quite active in the Organization of Ukrainian Nationals/Bandera (OUN/B) in France. He was ousted from the OUN/B because of his excessive curiosity about OUN/B members and their relatives in the USSR. Subsequently it was learned that KOZAK was in contact with the Soviet Embassy in France. KOZAK is presently residing at 26 rue Gaston Jaillon, Vesines Chalette, Loiret.

1. The purpose of this report is summarize the laboratory work done on two letters transmitted to us originally as attachments to Reference #1. For identification purposes in this report we shall refer to the letter postmarked in Philadelphia as Letter #1 and the one postmarked in the USSR as Letter #2.
2. In order to facilitate a better understanding of the results some interpretative data on the tests performed is included.
3. Because of the requirement that the letters be left in good condition to permit their delivery to the addressee, the initial examination consisted of the customary visual and U.V. inspection (including long wave and short wave), and the so-called KEMFOIE test. This latter test has only recently been introduced and constitutes the most formidable test known to us against SW. It was by means of this test that the presence of SW in Letter #1 became apparent. In the application of this test a portion of the SW is actually physically lifted from the item being tested and subsequently through a process involving both chemical and physical reactions, the SW is made visible. The degree of visibility varies from completely negative results to completely legible ones. According to the technician who performed this test the results obtained with Letter #1 were not quite legible, but definite enough to permit checking to establish that they were not due to the visible ink of the letter. The time interval during which this particular detection is observable lasts but a few minutes which the technician used to verify that he was detecting SW and not visible text. By the time he called in his two colleagues the reaction had progressed to the point that only one of these technicians was able to observe the SW. Thus the operator and one other technician saw the SW.
4. At this point the letters were returned to Paris with Reference #2 which reported "definite traces of SW" in Letter #1.
5. Before giving an account of the work done during the second phase of the investigation. (i.e., after the letters were returned to the laboratory for development) it should be pointed out that the KEMFOIE test, though an extremely effective test for the detection of SW, does not identify the system involved. Complete development of the secret message under these circumstances would have been almost impossible. The only alternative available to the chemist, and the one he followed in this particular case, is to proceed with a series of chemical tests applied directly to the document under investigation. These tests are applied in sequence, one after the other, each requiring for its execution that a portion of the page be sacrificed. It is therefore important that those tests affording the greatest probability of developing the SW be applied first; thus if and when, a test is found capable of developing the ink, the remainder of the page (i.e., the portion not affected by previous chemical applications) is treated with it.

6. In testing letter #1, the chemist endeavored to apply first those tests known to be effective in developing known SW (inks). (There are, however, SW inks for which we have no known developer.) After such tests were exhausted without yielding any detection the chemist proceeded with the application of other tests. In all a total of 20 different chemical tests were applied. No additional area was used except the more area was left on the letter to apply each.

7. None of these tests yielded even a trace of SW. These results appear to contradict the reports initially sent with reference #3. They should not be so interpreted. We would believe that before in connection SW, our failure to develop is notwithstanding.

8. As previously reported, Letter #2 was not treated, for reasons given in reference #3. A facsimile of letter #1 was made before undertaking its chemical treatment. The facsimile was checked by a competent linguist and authentication specialist and found satisfactory.

9. FBI: Any information concerning the KENFOLD test, including its existence, is considered extremely sensitive and should be so treated.

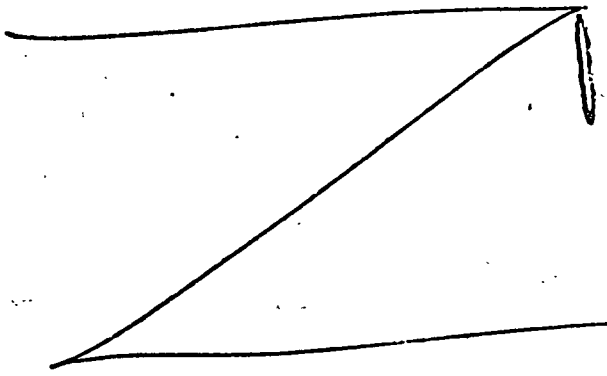
