1. COS Lima did well to raise the question as to what will happen, vis a vis our operational security, when the Cubans achieve diplomatic recognition in the various Latin American countries where this is gradually occurring. The responses from the Branches indicate that we do have a considerable amount of operational activity and equity that revolve around our Cuban assets and that we would do well to begin a gradual cut-back in our use of Cubans, given the targetting that we presume will be made on them as the Cuban CI effort begins in the various countries.

2. However, the solution to our problem should be a gradual one and keyed initially to where the official Cuban presence is, and then to those countries where it is coming. Therefore we start with Peru.

b. GICITRON-4, who has been Treasurer of the 26th July movement in the period 1957-58 provides the cover for LITHGOE.

- c. Cuban *7 months investigation*
- d. Legitimate businessman who was formerly in Mexico and now manages a Mexican business firm in Bogota.
- e. Resident alien of Colombia.
- f. Subject has received no training in clandestine operations, though he was involved in several clandestine Cuban activities while treasurer of the 26th of July Movement during 1957-58.
- g. Since Subject provides cover for LITHGOE, he is not required to utilize any tradecraft. Having his own company provides for adequate cover.
- h. Due to his position, Subject is probably well-known in the Cuban community, but he performs no operational tasks.

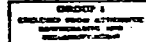

1. The receipt of Reference A Provisional Operational Approval for Subject was much appreciated. We were puzzled, however, by the request for PRQ Parts I and II on GICITRON-4 since all biographic and operational data on him with the exception of References and DIRECTOR 006731 is on record only at Headquarters as far as we are aware unless Mexico City has retained their old file on him. Paragraph 3 of Reference B specifically requested that pertinent material from Subject's 201 be forwarded to Bogotá, but we have never received it.

2. Errol C. Lythgoe, despite his old friendship with Subject, has no present justifiable reason consistent with cover to question him regarding all the biographic details required for preparation of a full PRQ Part I. Nor could Lythgoe logically elicit from Subject the answers to such PRQ Part II items as "How, when, where, why and by whom Subject was first contacted or developed" by KWROCK, "List other case officers who have handled Subject or whom he knows or has known...", and the like.

3. Subject's proposed present operational use is detailed in Reference B, and Headquarters has the rest of the basic data necessary for preparation of both parts of the PRQ. It is therefore suggested that this be done at Headquarters, with copies being forwarded to Bogotá for updating.

The following information is for your information regarding the activities of the reporting unit as set forth in the attached report. The activities have expanded considerably during July, and this report will attempt to give a bird's-eye view of the overall picture of the unit for future progress reporting. In summary during July 1962 the HUNTERS presented a new translation of the Cuban Embassy in Havana City and a list of four employees of that Embassy with surveillance being in effect. They had one of them functioning actively during the month; they located a short wave transmitter radio; they have a cover company possibility which is being seriously considered for activation; and they have approximately seven legal traveler registrations under development or active. The HUNTERS now number 13, practically all of
