ACTION REQUESTED: None, FYI

1. An MFO source, Alvaro HUMEZ Garcia, reported on 17 December 1961 that he had that day, by chance, met General E. GENEK, a former colleague of Dr. Arnulfo RODRIGUEZ in Guatemala who had been extremely anxious to have CASTRO liquidated. GENEK had asked GENEK about his visit to CHAVEZ, and when GENEK expressed his opinion, YOLMEZ said it was logical because CHAVEZ was extremely cowardly.

2. HUMEZ stated that GENEK had said that he was returning that day from a trip to Panama and Guatemala. In Panama he had talked to Presidente OCHOA and had found him to be indecisive, but, to the contrary, when he had talked to Presidente YOLMEZ in Guatemala he had found him extremely anxious to have CASTRO liquidated. YOLMEZ had asked GENEK about his visit to CHAVEZ, and when GENEK expressed his opinion, YOLMEZ said it was logical because CHAVEZ was extremely cowardly.

3. According to HUMEZ, GENEK further said that a short time ago he had been called by Mr. Bob Burwitz, Chief of the Cuban Desk in the State Department, and that Burwitz had told him not to fool around with SANCHEZ or Julio CARRASCO because the man who had the support of the U.S. was ANTONIO, and that as he, Burwitz, had knowledge of the great work done by GENEK, he did not want him to continue losing more time.

4. HUMEZ added that GENEK had said that a few days later he received a phone call from ANTONIO. GENEK told HUMEZ that he will help ANTONIO, because it was requested, but he would never have done so by his own wish.

5. HUMEZ said that GENEK continued his travel on to Washington, where he resides at 1119 - 17th Street, N.W., Washington 7.
