According to usually reliable Cuban exile sources in Madrid, the Subject was born in Poland on 5 February 1922; she became a Cuban citizen in 1945. Subject arrived in Madrid, Spain, on 12 May 1963, bearing Cuban passport #34059 issued on 24 July 1956. Her last known address in Cuba was Ronda 17, Apt. 18, Habana. (JFK) 5-30-98

The following is Subject's educational history:

- 1930 to 1936 - Primary school at Ludwipol, Poland
- 1938 to 1942 - High school-Instituto Marianao, Habana
- 1942 to 1947 - University of Habana (degree in Philosophy and Letters)
- 1958 - University of Columbia, New York (summer school studying German literature).

From 1956 to 1961, Subject was a professor of literature and languages at the Central University in Santa Clara, Las Villas. She held the same position from 1961 to 1962 at the University of Habana. She reportedly speaks English, German and Spanish fluently.
